	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Promote high standards of quality within the nursery in respect of the environment, resources and experiences offered to children.</li><li>• Provide professional and relevant feedback to parents/carers about their child.</li><li>• Ensure all records of development and learning are fully and accurately maintained by the appropriate staff.</li><li>• Ensure appropriate planning is in place to maintain the required standards consulting with the Senior Nursery Nurse when necessary.</li><li>• Provide leadership and support to playroom staff to enable them to establish and maintain positive working relationships.</li><li>• Deploy staff appropriately to ensure that the required standards are delivered and maintained within the play room.</li><li>• Ensure that practice and provision in the nursery meets the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage.</li><li>• Ensure the effective implementation of the nursery keycarer procedures and allocate children to keycarers appropriately.</li><li>• Ensure that children are kept safe and that staff understand and, when necessary, follow Safeguarding Procedures.</li><li>• Support the development of good practice with regards to special needs and inclusion.</li><li>• Implement and support others in delivering, the EYFS in line with current practice and guidelines.</li><li>• Develop and maintain highly professional working relationships with relevant Local Authority Departments, regulatory bodies and other agencies.</li></ul>
